Dear Honorable Mills:

Pursuant to R.S. 49:968(D)(1)(b), the Louisiana State Board of Dentistry (the "Board") hereby announces its plan to finalize the March 20, 2018, Notice of Intent that was published on pages 651-652 of the *Louisiana Register*. A copy of the rules, as published, are attached for your review. Also attached is the approved Fiscal and Economic Impact Statement.

The Louisiana State Board of Dentistry is amending LAC 46:XXXIII.1511 to require that every dentist who performs moderate or greater sedation must now have adequate equipment for the establishment of an intravenous infusion, regardless of the route of administration of the sedation.

The board did not receive any comments to these proposed rule changes or requests for a public hearing and no changes have been made to these proposed rules since initial publication in the March 20, 2018 edition of the Register. Therefore, subject to legislative oversight by either the House or Senate Health and Welfare Committees, the board intends to submit these rules to the Office of the State Register for publication on June 20, 2018. 


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
