Dear Honorable Mills:

Pursuant to R.S. 49:968(D)(1)(b), the Louisiana State Board of Dentistry (the "Board") hereby announces its plan to finalize the September 20, 2020, Notices of Intent that were published on pages 97-98 of the *Louisiana Register*. A copy of the rules, as published, is attached for your review. Also attached is the approved Fiscal and Economic Impact Statement.

The Louisiana State Board of Dentistry is amending LAC 46:XXXIII.322 to allow a dentist to apply for an expungement of a consent decree for a first time CDC inspection violation(s).

The Louisiana State Board of Dentistry is amending LAC 46:XXXIII.1502 to allow dentists to not have to obtain an office or personal permit for a nitrous oxide analgesia permit because the board deemed this permit unnecessary.

The Board did not receive any comments to these proposed rule changes or requests for a public hearing. Please be advised that there was a manifest error. In §322(B)(2) the inclusion of the word "advertising" was an accidental manifest error and should read as follows:


"2. the dentist has not had any subsequent disciplinary actions of any kind taken against him by the board or any other licensing or certifying agency since the initial CDC inspection violation in question;"

The Board will correct the manifest error at the time the Notices of Intent become rules for final promulgation by notifying Catherine Brindley at the Office of State Register.

Therefore, subject to legislative oversight by either the House or Senate Health and Welfare Committees, the Board intends to submit these rules to the Office of the State Register for publication on December 20, 2020. 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

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

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
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
